Regular Acting Practice

Core exercises to strengthen craft and emotional depth every week

1

Monologues

Develop emotional depth, character clarity, and personal voice through regular solo performance work.

2

Scene Work

Partner and ensemble scenes that sharpen listening, reaction, and truthful moment-to-moment interaction.

3

Improvisation Exercises

Strengthen instinct, spontaneity, and creative presence — the ability to think and respond truthfully under pressure.

Camera Practice Sessions

Translating stage presence into confident, natural screen performance

Actors will regularly practise performing in front of the camera inside the classroom — building comfort, confidence, and screen instinct with every session.

Screen Acting

Learn how performance translates differently on camera compared to the stage. Understand scale, subtlety, and truth in close-up.

Camera Awareness

Develop a natural relationship with the lens — finding marks, hitting frames, and maintaining continuity across takes.

Natural On-Camera Performance

Build the ease and authenticity that makes an actor magnetic on screen, removing self-consciousness through regular repetition.

Creative Film & Theatre Production

Collaborative projects that bring stories — and actors — to life

Participants will work together to create original projects using the resources and creative energy of the community.



Short Films

Originate and perform in short films, experiencing every stage from script reading to final shoot.



Feature-Length Films

Larger-scale collaborative productions that demand sustained character work and professional discipline.



Theatre Productions

Stage productions — from first rehearsal through opening night — building ensemble and live performance skills.

Collaborative Production Model

Real production experience — owned and created by the community

When the group decides to produce a project, production costs are shared collectively among participants.

How It Works

- 1 Costs shared equally among participants
- 2 Everyone takes on active production roles
- 3 Guided by faculty and industry professionals
- 4 From concept to completed final cut

- ▶ A finished film or stage credit
- ▶ Portfolio footage for auditions
- ▶ Network with cast, crew & collaborators

Extended Practice Sessions

Flexibility to go deeper when the work demands it

Optional – By Group Agreement

If required and agreed upon by the group, the number of practice days can be extended for specific projects or rehearsals.

This flexibility allows actors to develop deeper performances, complete complex rehearsal schedules, and bring creative projects to the highest possible standard.

Work on monologues, scenes, and scripts specifically chosen and prepared for real audition contexts.

Audition Performance Practice

Regular mock auditions to build confidence, reduce nerves, and refine both self-tape and live audition technique.
